New York City Temporary Amusement Device Operators

Businesses that operate amusement devices (e.g., Ferris Wheels, Tilt-A-Whirls, etc.) at street fairs, carnivals, or block parties require a Department of Consumer Affairs (DCA) license. As of **Wednesday**, **August 8**, **2012**, the following is a list of businesses that have submitted a DCA application for a Temporary Amusement Device license, including proof of insurance. The rides are pending an on-site inspection by the New York City Department of Buildings (DOB). Since DOB usually inspects the devices on the day of the event, be sure to look for an on-site license or "green tag" as proof that the device has passed inspection.
